3) Salon Subjects:

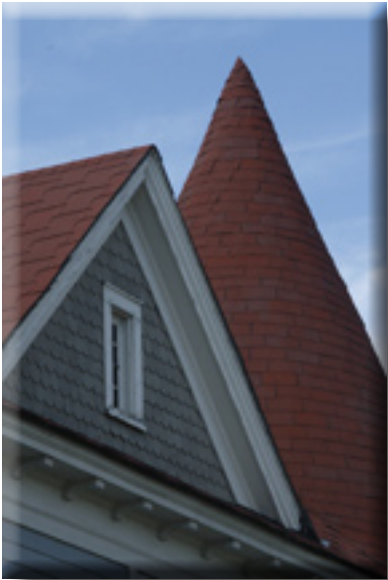
- a) Open - 8 slide entries

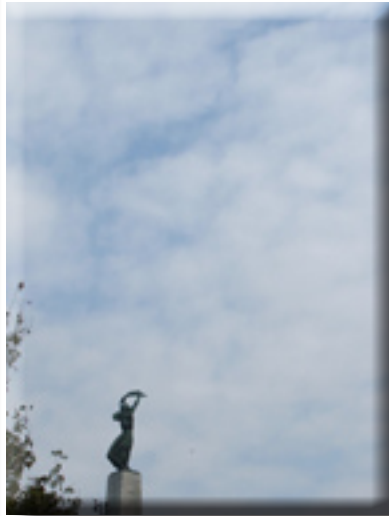
The work night for the Salon will be November 22nd at Bills and Judging will be on November 25th at LSWC 7PM. We moved it up a week to give everyone more time.

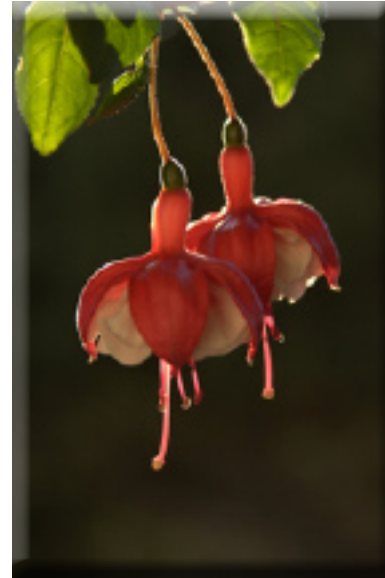

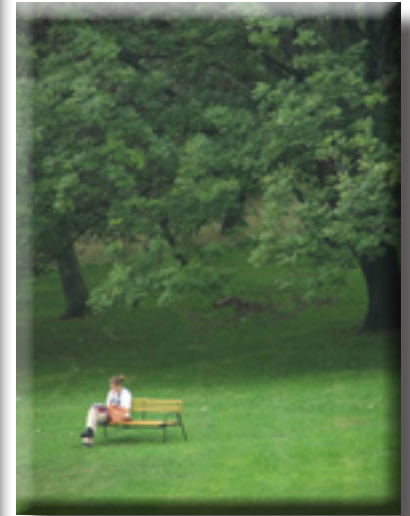
