The awards are for the highest total points in the Salon subject and open competitions as well as for the highest total points for the year's monthly competitions. Every member is invited to the Banquet. You may bring a guest with you. There is a \$4.00 fee for each person. I (Chef Ellis) am the Salon Banquet Coordinator. If you attend, you must bring something. I don't care if you can't boil water. Go to the grocery store and buy something already prepared. 2014 Monthly Competition Subjects

January - Fires: any image of a fire or its aftermath

May - Wearing many different hats: person or animal or object wearing any type of hat, helmet or scarf, etc.

June - Jailhouse Blues: any structure or location that holds incarcerated people - jail, prison, police van, internment camp, etc.

July - Unusual Rock Formations: any natural, scenic geological feature- GOG, Paint Mines, Volcano, Slot Canyon, Cave Formation, etc.

August - Bírds of a Feather: natural or captíve shot of a single bírd or group of bírds - flock of geese, bírds at a feeder, pet parakeet, etc.

September - Open Competition and Critique Night

October - River: Any size - natural or from a flood
